The candidate is familiar with CCL, brings instructional expertise, and shares a passion for transforming learning experiences for young people across Colorado's middle and high schools.

The Assistant Director will be responsible for tracking the evolving landscape of AI in K-12 education, staying ahead of emerging AI trends, resources, and research to inform implementation strategies. With an ability to build strong relationships with educators and school district leaders, they will collaborate with others on the CEI team to design and deliver implementation support and lead internal project management. The Assistant Director will also work with school leaders, educators, postsecondary and industry partners, and community stakeholders to develop CCL programs and systems that prepare students for future careers.

- Lead and co-lead implementation of CCL projects. Based on relevant experience, this could include Career and Technical Education (CTE), pathways design, internship programming, concurrent enrollment, industry credentials, and/or work-based learning experiences.
- Lead the integration of AI into CCL learning experiences, including incorporation of digital literacy and AI
 competencies into work-based learning.
- Partner with school leaders, educators, and postsecondary and industry partners to develop CCL systems and programs.
- Work collaboratively with internal and external teams to build cross-team relationships, demonstrate flexibility and openness to different viewpoints, and commitment to collective success.

Coaching and Facilitation

- Plan and facilitate discussions, workshops/sessions, and project-specific convenings that engage and
 inspire participants, including development of supporting materials for in-person and virtual convenings
 (agendas, decks, tools, resources, etc.).
- Coach individuals and teams to enhance their skills and achieve their potential.

Thought Leadership and Communication

- Research emerging AI trends, resources, and research to inform implementation strategies and share with internal team members
- Participate in strategic planning sessions; use data to drive decisions.
- Utilize excellent written and verbal skills to translate complex information for diverse stakeholders.

Qualifications

In addition to the competencies noted above, a successful candidate has five plus years of professional experience in education or related sectors and demonstrated experience with technology in education, including knowledge of AI tools, ethics, policies, and best practices. Additionally, they have instructional expertise, ideally in AI and/or STEM, and familiarity with Colorado's education system, CCL initiatives, and project-based learning.

Candidates will anticipate and take the initiative to solve problems and know how to work across teams to build relationships and develop collaborative work products. They have a record of working with humility and persistence to serve partners and teams to whom they are accountable, with outstanding interpersonal skills.

They are organized, detail-oriented, and are an outstanding verbal and written communicator, who can manage multiple projects simultaneously in partnership with leaders and peers who need the support of an outstanding project manager. They are an assets-based educator, who is passionate about building relationships and sees opportunity for excellence across the entire state of Colorado. They are a strong facilitator in both in-person and virtual contexts and have expertise and knowledge of adult learning techniques. A creative and curious mindset and a deep commitment to student success are essential in this role. The candidate must be available and willing to travel as needed, up to 50 percent of working days, mostly within Colorado.
